The meeting was called to order at 11:05 a.m. by Chairperson, Cathy Buffington.

The meeting was approved on a motion by Connie Larson, second by Jack Seward. Motion carried 5-0.

Public Health

Danielle Pettit-Majewski introduced Jim Hobart, Hobart Historic Restoration, to present preliminary information and finance options for the restoration of the McCleary building. Jim provided options for financing, information on the building, and answered questions from the Board regarding the entire project. A recommendation to present the Hobart options to the Board of Supervisors, with preference given to option A (rent to own), was approved on a motion by Chris Grier, second by Trevor Martin. Motion carried 4-0. Jack Seward abstained.

The recommendation for an amendment to the Board of Health employee handbook was postponed with the intent of further discussion at a subsequent meeting.

Danielle shared that Leann Fangman, Registered Dental Hygienist, started her employment with WCPH on January 5th. Leann was hired as a 40 hour/FT employee. The personnel change request was approved on a motion by Chris Grier, second by Trevor Martin. Motion carried 5-0.
