The meeting was called to order at 12:02 p.m. by Chairperson, Cathy Buffington.

The meeting agenda from October 27th was approved on a motion by Jack Seward, second by Chris Grier. Motion carried 5-0. The agenda was approved on a motion by Connie Larson, second by Chris Grier. Motion carried 5-0.

Danielle Pettit-Majewski initiated conversation about the upcoming term expirations for Chris Grier and Connie Larson. The approval to send the nomination of Chris Grier and Connie Larson for new terms to the Board of Supervisors was granted on a motion by Jack Seward, second by Cathy Buffington. Motion carried 5-0.

Public Health

Peggy Wood presented the agency financial report. She noted that revenue and expenses are within budgetary guidelines.

Danielle presented the annual Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) self assessment for approval. The assessment is required by the Department of Human Services (DHS) each year in order to continue waiver services. Approval for submission was granted on a motion by Chris Grier, second by Trevor Martin. Motion carried 5-0.

A Maternal, Child, Adolescent Health (MCAH) update was given by Danielle. She highlighted success stories within the program. Additionally, Danielle shared Women, Infant, and Children (WIC) stats for Washington County. She shared that in the past fiscal year, Washington County served approximately 215 people, on average, per month.

Environmental Health

Jennine Wolf presented the budget -Revenue is at 346% and expenditures are at 26%.

Jennine explained the department did not receive the Riverboat Foundation grant for the hand washing stations.
