Nurse

- ♥ Assist in obtaining a physician
- ♥ Offer prenatal education
- ♥ Supply prenatal vitamins
- ♥ Schedule prenatal and postpartum home visit with maternal health nurse
- ♥ Educate and support infant feeding practices
- ♥ Breastfeeding support
- ♥ Screen for prenatal and postpartum depression

Social Work

- ♥ Perform social assessment and resource & referral
- ♥ Assist in obtaining appropriate payment source
- ♥ Arrange for dental screening assessment, fluoride varnish, education and referral for dental care
- ♥ Offer preventative dental services on an appointment basis for pregnant women who are underserved

WIC

- ♥ Provide nutrition evaluation and education
